



## RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

1. **Pure Crabbet Horses** = Horses of 100% Crabbet breeding/bloodlines only.
2. \*Crabbet is defined as \*Descended from Pure Arabian horses purchased, owned or bred by Wilfred Blunt, Lady Anne Blunt, Lady Wentworth or Crabbet Park Stud.
3. **NOTE:** Pure Crabbet horses are eligible to enter **ALL** Purebred Classes i.e. Pure Crabbet Classes, Crabbet 75% & over classes and Open Purebred Classes.
4. **An extended pedigree on the "CHG Pedigree Form" to be submitted for all Crabbet bred entries in Ring 1 The Crabbet Ring.**
5. This event will be conducted under the current Rule Book of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Limited and the Rules set herein. Copies of the AHSA Rule Book are available on their website [www.ahsa.asn.au](http://www.ahsa.asn.au).
6. All horses must be registered with A.H.S.A Ltd. Proof of registration must be available on request. **A Photocopy of both sides of registration (OLD CERIFICATE) or front of new A4 Certificates' to accompany entries or entries will not be accepted.**
7. Birth date of all horses to be taken from 1st of August. All ridden horses must be 3 years and over.
8. Stallions and colts must be handled or ridden by a person 18 years and over.
9. Geldings shown in gelding classes must have been gelded. Colts registered as geldings cannot compete.
10. Geldings are only eligible for Supreme Gelding Award. Geldings therefore are not permitted to compete for other Supreme led awards.
11. Veteran horses may compete in other led classes in their age group.
12. The judge's decision in all cases is final. Verbal or physical abuse to Judges, Officials, Committee Members, Stewards or any other person will result in instant disqualification of all exhibit/s entered by the exhibitor or handler at the committees discretion.
13. Horses displaying any whip marks or any signs of abuse, are not to be judged.
14. Entry fees will not be refunded without a medical or vet certificate.
15. Broodmares must have a foal at foot or be visibly in foal in the current season. A vet certificate must accompany Mares in foal with entries.
16. Foals must be led by a capable handler.
17. All riders must wear an Australian Safety Approved riding helmet at all times whilst on a horse within the AELEC precinct. Unless otherwise allowed or required in classes.
18. No responsibility will be taken for any damage, loss or accident that may be caused or suffered by any exhibit or person, and it is a condition of entry that everyone shall hold the organizers indemnified against any claim in respect of any accident, loss or damage
19. All horses must match their brands and markings as per Certificate of Registration.

20. Whip Length for ridden 75cm and halter is 110cm including handle and thong. Handlers may not raise **any part** of their whips above their shoulder.

**Penalty for NON compliance could result in disqualification from the show in ALL classes.**

21. Exhibits are not to be deliberately stirred or razzed up in any way; horses must remain calm in the marshalling area with the maximum of one handler and one groom. No devices, artificial gadgets or loud noises shall be used within the AELEC precinct to excite horses. This rule also applies to other person outside of the marshalling area and the show ring. Exhibits that are excessively excited may be asked to leave the show ring or the marshalling area if they are disturbing or upsetting other horses. Handlers are not to excite stallions to challenge each other by facing them up to each other or crowding them. The facing of stallions is strictly prohibited.
22. The show organizers shall have the power to cancel, divide or combine classes, Remove any exhibit or exhibitor from the ground or reject or cancel any entry at any time.
23. Novice under saddle is a hack which has not won a first place in an Open Hack Class, or Championship (Novice or Open) at any Official Show at the closing date of entry. To be able to perform at Maiden level. Walk, trot and canter with simple change of lead through the trot and transitions of pace. Lengthening of stride at the trot may be asked. To be ridden in a snaffle bit with Dropped/Hanoverian or cavesson nose band.
24. Elementary under saddle is a hack which has not won a first place at Elementary or Open level or a Championship (Elementary or Open) at an Official Show at the closing date of entry. To be able to perform as at novice level plus ability to show some collection and/or lengthening (Extension) at the walk, trot and canter; lengthened canter, rein back a determined number of strides, simple change of leg at canter (3-5 strides at trot or walk), simple transitions of pace. To be ridden in a snaffle or double bridle.
25. Newcomer under saddle is defined as a horse that has not competed under saddle prior to 1st August 2010. The exhibit must be ridden in a snaffle, whips and spurs are not permitted.
26. Amateur owner: As per AHSA Rules, horses entered must be registered/leased in the handlers' or their immediate family's name. A copy of Amateur card is to accompany entry forms.
27. Dual registered entries must supply both certificates with entries
28. All exhibits must have their exhibit number prominently displayed either on the horse or handler/rider before entering the ring.
29. All exhibit numbers must be returned to the secretaries' office. A \$5 deposit will be charged for all numbers and refunded upon their return in good condition
30. Dogs are **NOT** permitted.
31. It is the Exhibitors & Visitor's responsibility to ensure you are aware of the AELEC Rules and Regulations and abide by them at all times.
